

## **Four-hundred natural gas market decision-makers meet to analyze and discuss plans to buy, sell and transport natural gas in the Southeast U.S. market**

In addition, Mark Boling, CEO, 2C Energy, LLC will also deliver a presentation on The Role of Natural Gas in a Low-Carbon Economy.

The 2 ½ day Program also includes six moderated Panel discussions addressing a variety of timely topics, with well-qualified industry experts, including representatives from: CenterPoint Energy Services; Eversheds-Sutherland; Renewable Natural Gas (RNG) Coalition; Direct Energy; Center for LNG; ICIS; ConocoPhillips; Thigpen Solutions; Stabilis Energy; Chart Inc.; Marlin Gas Services; Kinder Morgan; Dominion Energy / Atlantic Coast Pipeline; Williams; Sequent Energy Management; NatGasHub.com; CX Futures Exchange; FIS Global; American Public Gas Association; City of Wilson; City of Tallahassee; and Huntsville Utilities.
